# Peninsula local wins Clarence Citizen of the Year 2019

Kerry Scambler was named as Citizen of the Year for her work with the South Arm Peninsula Residents Association (SAPRA) over a long period.

Kerry joined SAPRA in January 1995 as Secretary and, apart from a 3 ½ year break, has spent over 20 years as Secretary, Treasurer and President. Those years have seen the building and various iterations of the Community Centre (including the recent rejuvenation with the Library, History Room and Op Shop), the Community Bus, Convict Trail, the Labyrinth, public seating, boat ramp and jetty improvements and innumerable meetings both locally and further afield.

These projects were driven by many people with Kerry providing valuable support, advice and connections as well as applying for grants to bring projects to fruition.

When accepting her award, Kerry paid tribute to the wonderful community of South Arm and the work done by so many smaller groups and individuals. Described as a community connector in the nomination, Kerry said she" always aims to support good people, help them get what they need and get out of the way while they get on with it."

# Changes to Bus Services

On January 20th 2019, Department of State Growth implemented changes to the public bus service contracted to Metro and servicing the Peninsula region. These changes came without warning and without consultation with any current bus users or citizens of the Peninsula region. Individual letters from locals to State Growth have been responded to with a generic reply. Whilst we are pleased with the introduction of 3 bus services on weekends, it appears to have come at the expense of the following:

- · Halving the number of weekday services;
- Cancellation of all bus servicing to Gellibrand and Rifle Range roads in Sandford, excepting one school run, on school days;
- Cancellation of express bus services to Cremorne and Clifton Beach and the inclusion of stops at Rosny park, resulting in very long bus trip to South Arm and Opossum bay
- Cancellation of a number of day-time weekday services, may prevent our elderly, unemployed & those without cars to get to & from appointments, job interviews or shopping, during the day.
- Removal of an evening bus service on weekdays, impacting work overtime or evening socialisation
- 9-5 commuters from Opossum Bay and South Arm are faced with a 12 hour day during school holidays and an 11.5 hour day on school days, if opting to use the bus to and from work.

Public backlash to timetable changes was swift and loud. As a result, a petition was established to run for 9 days. At the time of writing (5 days in) over 100 people have put their names to the petition, indicating displeasure with the changes. By the end of January, a meeting will have been arranged with a State Government Minister to table this petition and seek community consultation and urgent review of the changes.

We regular bus users would encourage Government to ask the Peninsula community how to increase user numbers rather than cutting services. If State Growth looks at user data in 12 months time, it may see a large reduction due to timetable changes, which could jeapordise the continued viability of a Peninsula bus service.

# Arm End - RITF

Arm End was reserved for the public to engage with its unique location and environment. RITE was formed to protect, enhance and recognise the cultural and natural values of Arm End reserve.

It is 6 years since the first Arm End golf course proposal was approved by Clarence City Council in March 2013. The lease was issued by Parks and Wildlife Service Dec 2014. A revised proposal submitted to Council late 2015 was approved in April 2016, adding a 30m long maintenance shed and plant nursery, relocating the cafe and change rooms to a prominent hill - visually intrusive. In April 2018 Council extended the planning permit for 2 years.

In November 2018 the proponent applied to Council for approval for a pipeline to take treated effluent from the Blackmans Bay sewerage treatment plant across the Derwent River, then along South Arm Road to Arm End to irrigate the fairways and greens. RITE is concerned about the possibility of health risks and loss of public access if the application is approved.

RITE (Re-Imagine The End) has been set up to seek community ideas about an alternative vision for Arm End Reserve and to campaign to stop the golf course.

In April 2020 the proponent can seek a third and final two year permit from Council. RITE wants to convince Council to not approve this extension to allow progress on its alternative vision for Arm End.

The Blackmans Bay to South Arm Irrigation Water Project will harness a wasted water resource being dumped into the Derwent River at Blackmans Bay.

Already, eight South Arm farmers have expressed their interest in the irrigation uquality water, which will be available to all, as well as the Arm End project. Arm End believes using recycled water reflects environmental, economic & social sustainability.

The approvals process for the pipeline has taken guite some time and we thank you for your ongoing patience and support. If pipeline approvals and permits are obtained, we will rapidly work towards commencement for the Arm End Multi Use Reserve as well as the pipeline construction project.



Kirstie has been gathering petition signatures and lobbying at every opportunity.




In the meantime services are continuing as usual on the **2nd and 4th Sundays, at 4pm**, followed by a meal.

# Opossum Bay South Arm & Coastcare

Throughout 2018, Coastcare continued to remove Boxthorn and Boneseed, our target weeds - we have eradicated it from the Arm End reserve. The removal of a large Boneseed infestation on private properties in Opossum Bay should be completed in 2019.

We received a grant from Landcare Tasmania for Boxthorn removal in Opossum Bay last year and this year we received a \$5,000 grant from Clarence City Council to remove boxthorn plants along Bezzants Track in South Arm. Both these projects include revegetation with endemic species.

Our current project to remove Boxthorn at Glenvar, (historical property in Opossum Bay) has progressed about halfway. Coastcare have removed a tremendous amount of Boxthorn patches - piles upon piles, which can be seen from South Arm Road. This project would not be possible without dedicated Coastcare volunteers and the Landcare Tasmania grant which funded professional contractors to chainsaw boxthorn plants.

OBSAC aims to alternate working bees on the second Sunday 10-12pm of every month between Opossum Bay and South Arm areas. Stay tuned for the 2019 schedule which will be posted at the South Arm Store and Opossum Bay & South Arm Facebook page.
