Bushfire Threat Remains



South Arm Fire Brigade

has had a quieter year compared with 2019, but our members have still been regularly asked to help out with the mainland fires. We have had a few grass and bush fires as a result of human error, plus a devastating house fire.

We all know how dry it was earlier this year, and this has caught a few residents off guard. **Please always** call the TFS on 1800 000 699 before lighting any outside fire. They will tell you if you need a permit, if the weather forecast is unfavorable, and also register the burn to ensure we don't get called out by mistake.

We are lucky to have six new members, and our recent training has focused on skilling them up. This includes a thorough induction into the TFS, basic training on all our equipment, radios, rural navigation, fire behavior plus local risks and hazards. We have a wonderful community filled with volunteers in so many areas, and I'm glad we have managed to grab another six!

As we head back into the colder months, its time to think about your home fire safety plan.

This may mean:

- Changing batteries testing/vacuuming smoke alarms.
- · Checking electric blankets for damage before use.
- · Getting chimneys cleaned.
- Ensuring power-points aren't overloaded.
- Cleaning filters in dryers and heaters.
- Basic safety around candles and cigarettes.

Perhaps it is as simple as thinking about your escape plan. Can you easily reach your exit in the dark/smoke? Do you have a second exit? Do you have easy access to keys for any window/door that is deadlocked? Have you checked that your home insurance is up to date?

Rather than being fearful of house fires, it is far more useful to be prepared. A working smoke alarm will save your life in a fire. The TFS website has plenty of info on where to install your alarm, as well as simple tips to reduce fire risks in and around your home.

Did you know the *REDcycle* soft plastics recycling service is now available in Coles & Woolworths supermarkets across Tasmania?

Soft plastic that can be 'scrunched' is accepted for recycling via these special collection bins. (*not via kerbside recycling bins!*).

Some examples of the soft plastics that can be dropped off at the special *redcycle* recycling bins:

- Plastic bags
- Bread bags (ties and tags removed)
- Foil lined chip packets
- Frozen food and veggie bags
- Confectionery bags
- Cereal box liner bags
- Old 'green' reusable shopping bags
- Rice and pasta packets
- Plastic wrap from the outside of toilet paper and paper towels
- Large pieces of plastic that furniture comes wrapped in (cut in to A3 sized pieces).

Update March 2020

The Arm End Team would like to thank all community members who took part in our onsite consultations last month.

More than 50 people attended the gathering and discussions at Arm End itself and some 25 people, the majority of them nearby residents, came to the onsite discussion at Algona St, where the Reuse Water Pipeline will come ashore from Blackmans Bay.

Reuse Water Pipeline

After detailed consultation with regulatory authorities – Parks and Wildlife and Council – our engineering designers, and other required contractors and sub-contractors, we have decided to postpone the Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) component of the pipeline project.

The options are to reschedule the works for late May/June this year and complete before the start of the Handfish breeding season or most likely undertake these activities after November 15th, 2020, when the breeding/spawning season has finished.

We have recently completed the geotechnical drilling investigation and reporting. This information has been used for the detail design and constructions drawings for the HDD works.

The project team is also progressing the following Pipeline works:

- Water agreement with TasWater now progressed to the final details of the contract negotiations
- Internal TasWater approvals for Blackmans Bay site layout and design requirements for reuse water infrastructure

We have been liaising with the EPA and Council, discussing the regulatory requirements for the use of the reuse water.

Arm End Site

We have completed the detailed site survey and are continuing with the pre-construction approval conditions, including the Construction Environmental Management Plan, that will manage works on site. The detailed golf course and landscaping design is progressing and we are continuing the weed management works, maintenance of tracks and preparation works onsite.

We have also commenced discussions with Greening Australia, Birdlife Tasmania and Aboriginal Heritage Tasmania, to lead us in the management and utilisation of the Spit Area as a designated cultural heritage and environmental/ habitat refuge, for the Aboriginal heritage/bird values, as well as completing a direct seedling trial that involves planting native species, in particular Eucalyptus morrisbyi (rare and endangered).



How's these tomatoes? They look good enough to gobble down! The Community Garden grows magnificent tomatoes but these are surely the biggest and most colourful of all.



Save Saint Barnabas Milestone

A milestone has been achieved with community efforts to take ownership of our historic St Barnabas Church and Cemetery.

The Anglican Diocese advised that its Property Board has agreed in-principle to our community taking over the ownership, management and operation of St Barnabas Church & Cemetery and Gellibrand Fellowship Hall.

The Diocese is now working through the many formalities at their end to transfer property ownership to our community.

A Management Committee is now being formed to become the incorporated body required to work through the sale process, take ownership of St Barnabas and guide its first steps to a new future in community hands. Given the governance required for a property of this complexity, particularly complying with the Burials Act, building and planning regulations etc, the Management Committee will require specific

Once the management body is in place, an agreement will be signed with the Diocese followed by a formal contract of sale. Until that time, no details of the conditions of sale will be made publicly available, in respect to the negotiations made in good faith to date. We hope the transfer of ownership will be completed by the end of the year.

Once those legalities are finalised and signed off, an official announcement and celebration will be arranged to mark another major achievement by the South Arm community and all those who have supported the efforts.

This wonderful outcome which, whilst not finalised as yet, is the result of much hard work from those in our St Barnabas Working Group, assisted by SAPRA, and the support of the community. Thank you all.
