It is a known fact that the Jumbo bin system has many drawbacks. Some of the problems are directly attributed to the abuse of this system. The Jumbo bins are only to be used for household refuse and not other rubbish, e.g. garden rubbish, car parts etc. The Clarence Council is proposing a roadside pick-up service - 'at a price!' - approx \$48.60 per annum on top of our rates.
