

Anglican Diocese recants intention to sell St Barnabas Church to South Arm community

A group of around 25 community members attended the Annual General Meeting for St Barnabas Community Church South Arm (inc) on August 27th. The Board shared with the group the progress made so far in actioning the clear community wish to purchase and manage the church so that the spiritual life of the community grows and is ongoing.

It was with disappointment and frustration that the Board advised the group that the Anglican Diocese had reneged on their intention to sell the church and withdrew St Barnabas Church from sale on the 19th of August. This was in contrast to the stated intention to sell, being confirmed in early August.

From 2018 SAPRA, the St Barnabas Working Group and the incorporated Board that evolved to manage the sale process and beyond, have worked tirelessly to raise sufficient funds to complete the sale of the church and manage the sale process. From August 2020 the incorporated Board have focused on –

- satisfying government cemetery management requirements
- · improving the church and cemetery grounds
- · conducting audits of cemetery plots
- identifying requirements to ensure that there is access for all to the church
- regularly liaising with the Anglican Diocese to meet their needs and
- · ensuring building and fire safety compliance.

At the meeting it was agreed that a strongly worded letter will be sent to the Bishop expressing the community's frustration and disappointment at the outcome.

It has been proved that the church is viable and prospering, with regular Sunday morning services, and a spiritual team that ensures community needs are respected. As the Anglican Diocese plans for the church evolve, weekly 10:00am services will continue for the whole community, catering for all denominations. Special family and children ministry will begin shortly. Information about these services can be obtained from Jane Beavan (6239 9244).

The Anglican Diocese is well aware they need to rebuild trust and faith with the community to overcome anger and frustration. Rebuilding this will only occur through a strong community presence.

The Management Board's ongoing role is to ensure that all pledges are returned to community members and the processes for dissolving the board are abided by.





South Arm Brigade

South Arm Brigade has been busy over the last month training and refreshing new skills, culminating in a trip to Hobart to train on the Road Crash Rescue and HAZMAT truck. Whilst these specialist skills are undertaken by career firefighters in town, the reality is that volunteers will often be the first on scene and need to know how to deal with such emergencies.

We have also completed first aid training, familiarisation with key local hazards and a full-scale exercise at the school (fire, search, rescue, first aid and extinguishment).

The entire Brigade has now completed the level one qualification, which is a significant undertaking.

Fire safety in spring

As the days start warming up, the Fire Service has been called to a number of escaped burns around the State, mainly as a result of strong winds.

If you're planning to conduct a burn, remember to:

- Check fire restrictions with your local council and register your burn with TFS on 1800 000 699.
- · Apply for a fire permit if required.
- Check and monitor weather conditions particularly wind.
- To avoid unnecessary calls to emergency services, notify your neighbours beforehand.
- Leave a three-metre, bare earth fire break around the burn, free from flammable materials.
- · Have sufficient equipment & water to stop the fire spreading.

Never leave a burn unattended - stay for its entire duration.

If it gets out of control, call triple zero (000) immediately.



Let's keep the Peninsula safe

Following reports of recent dog attacks on animals lving on property bordering popular walking tracks, one resulting in a person requiring stitches, it is timely to consider safe dog walking practices.

Unfortunately, even good natured, well-trained doggos are slaves to their natural instincts and, as has recently happened, cannot always resist their intstinct to hunt.

So, to avoid possible embarrassment, injury, trauma or even fines or worse, please remember that the Dog Control Act 2000 requires that all dogs be under effective control on a road, in a built-up area or any other public space where a dog must be on a lead. Effective control means secured and restrained by a lead (no more than 2 metres long) held by a person able to control the dog.

It doesn't take much to keep all creatures great and small safe and avoid hurt and heartache, so please do the right thing by keeping your dogs on their leads - simple, secure and safe!


