Local volunteers...many hands

Did you know there are steady little bands of volunteers pottering about your community making South Arm the lovely area that it is?

In Opossum Bay we have a group who take pride in our public park. We weed, chat, prune and sometimes plant. An hour flies by and sometimes we finish with a coffee and cake.

In South Arm we have a group who get together once a month and work in the Community Garden. There are a couple of Wicking Beds there (the kind that suck moisture up through the bed from a well at the bottom) that enable veggies to be grown all year using minimal water. This garden is not just about veggies however, with the new pizza oven as centrepiece, we need your help to turn it into an inviting outdoor community space where groups can gather or have functions and entertainment. South Arm also has a small native garden and the group that care for that garden also keep an eye on the local verges.

Coastcare are preserving natural vegetation and making sure that weed plants do not take over our coastal reserves. We learn about native vegetation, rehabilitate through plantings and learn about managing weeds.





Tasmania Fire Service's community education program, Bushfire-Ready Neighbourhoods (BRN), has been in the South Arm Peninsula area for almost 2 years and the time is near for BRN to move onto another high bushfire risk area of southern Tasmania.



The next few months is your last chance to invite Community Development Officer Lesley King of BRN to come along and chat with your group or neighbourhood about bushfire risk and your survival planning. You may be thinking of starting an emergency phone tree network for your street or need further detail about how to manage the bushfire risk around your home, this is something Lesley can come and assist with and of course your local TFS volunteer brigade continue to support local community safety.

CELEBRATING THE NEW WOOD FIRED OVEN

This is a pizza dough that freezes beautifully and is perfect for the new wood fired oven. Gather your favourite pizza ingredients - you might even be able to pinch something from the Iron Plot.

Ingredients:

- 2 tsp dried yeast
- 2 tsp sugar
- ½ cup warm skim milk
- ¾ tsp salt
- 3 ½ cups plain flour
- ½ cup of Polenta
- 200 gms of thick natural yoghurt

Method:

- Combine all dry ingredients in the processor or mix by hand
- Combine warm milk and yoghurt and add to the dry mix
- Knead dough by hand or with a processor
- Roll out and cut with a pastry cutter, mug or large cup
- Fill with the leftover pizza ingredients or make up your own

NOTES: Makes 12. You can fill calzone with anything you wish but always use cooked meat, as cooking time is fast and ingredients are only being warmed while the outside in cooking.
