Talk to a doctor without leaving South Arm

Telehealth enables patients to interact with a doctor via a video linked conference call and it's long been used in rural/remote mainland areas. It's now available at the South Arm Community Centre thanks to local health professional, Kirstie Judd.

GP telehealth provides any medical service that doesn't need the doctor to physically examine the patient (noting there is a Registered Nurse on hand). Medicare doesn't subsidise this service currently, but this may change in future.

Practice Manger & RN Kirstie Judd has completed a Diploma of Applied Science (Nursing), and a Bachelor of Nursing (Monash). She has over 27 years experience in varied areas of health and in volunteer roles with Red Cross and Lifeline.

Dr Sharon Maja (MBchB, FRACGP, Executive MBA), has been practising medicine for 20 years. She is currently doing rural and remote locum services around Australia and is looking forward to caring for patients on our Peninsula.



Saver Plus is a free ten-month savings program providing financial education, budgeting and savings tips.

Participants receive up to \$500 in matched savings for educations costs such as laptops and tablets, uniforms and shoes, vocational education, lessons and activities, books and supplies, camps and school trips.

To be eligible, participants must be at least 18 years old, have a child at school or attend study or training themselves, have income from work (themselves or their partner, full time, part time, casual, seasonal work), have a current Health Care or Pension card and receive a Centrelink payment.

FAQs - South Arm Oval Landscaping

With the removal of the pine trees, Council has started the landscaping project so if you're curious about it, here's some basics:

What plants are going in?

Australian native species suitable to this location and landscape & selected for low water requirements with many for bird attracting and screening properties.

Why are they small plants?

Cost restrictions (large trees can cost \$100s/\$1000s) plus larger plants may fail because of poor moisture content in the soil and the heavy water use required to establish and sustain mature species. The watering regime of large established plants/trees simply isn't viable.

Who's looking after them?

For the first 12 months Council will be maintaining them then an assessment will be made on whether another 12 months is needed.

Where's the water coming from?

A separate water tank specifically for watering has gone in next to the Community Centre's existing tank. This will be filled by Council.

Is the community involved?

Everyone is welcome to help in watering the plants to help them establish and maintain moisture in the soil. The odd bucket of recycled waste water is most appreciated! Please observe the plant growth and let Council know of any major losses due to grazing animals or other causes.


