ST BARNABAS CHURCH and CEMETERY UPDATE

The St Barnabas Working Group has continued working on the community's wish for our church and cemetery to be owned and managed by the community, and kept as a place of worship.

Our submission has gone to the Anglican Diocese of Tasmania and we await the decision on the



1st December. Our aim is for ownership to be transferred to a suitable community organisation, the format of which is being worked on. It will need to comply with the State Government's proposed amended Burial & Cremations Act for cemetery managers - i.e. must be a body corporate with a succession plan.

In the meantime, we need to keep raising funds so we're ready when the moment comes to take back our church and start a new and more vibrant chapter of its long history! Remember pledges are only called upon when required and identifiable donations can be returned on request (over \$50) if we're not successful. Events, like the Quiz Night (see page 9) and regular stall at the Market, are also being planned so keep an eye out for them!



A new dedicated hotline is up and running in Tasmania to ensure reports of injured birds of prey can be responded to immediately. The 1800RAPTOR Hotline helps to ensure injured birds can get the care they need as soon as possible.



The Raptor and Wildlife Refuge has been working hard for a number of years to successfully rehabilitate birds of prey before they are released back into the wild where they belong.

For an injured bird to have the best chance of survival, let alone rehabilitation, time is critical.

This commitment follows the signing of a Deed of Agreement between the Raptor and Wildlife Refuge and the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment (DPIPWE).

New Committee members? Three potential new members came to our last meeting, and all made valuable contributions so we hope they formally put their hands up at our forthcoming AGM! (See page 9).




SAPRA AGM & GENERAL MEETING
