Preparing for Summer Bushfires

As the warmer weather approaches all property owners should be making sure they have cleared away any fire hazards that exist on their properties. With the recent early season fire events interstate and the protracted fire season that occurred here in Tasmania last summer we all need no reminder of the high risk associated with summer wildfires and everyone should take all steps necessary to reduce the risk of fire in the landscape.

What steps can you take to prepare your place?

- · Slashing and removing any long grass;
- · Trimming and removal of overhanging trees;
- Clearing roofing gutters of leaf build up;
- Relocate wood piles so they are not stacked against the walls of your house;
- · Remove rubbish or debris that may have accumulated near structures; and
- Clear any vegetation that may catch alight if burning embers or sparks land on your property.

Every property owner has this responsibility to make sure their assets are safe from fire and that any fire on their land does not escape to adjoining properties.



Arm End Public Recreational Area + Golf Course Set to Open Mid-2022

We are now ready to move on to site after 10 years of approvals and appeals and confident that work will begin within three months.

This development was first proposed in 2009 with the first iteration approved by Clarence City Council in 2012.

The proposal has been slowed down by lengthy approvals and bureaucratic processes as well as appeals to the planning tribunal. Perhaps the biggest hurdle was finding the best solution to get water to the site. Earlier this year, a 6.8km pipeline to pump recycled water from Blackmans Bay (where it currently is being piped into the river) to the South Arm Peninsula was approved. That process itself took over two years.

This will provide high quality recycled water from TasWater's Blackmans Bay treatment plant across the River Derwent to irrigate the Arm End Public Recreation Reserve as well as local farms and properties should they wish.

We're glad to have successfully negotiated our way through the 10-year approvals process and are excited to start work on providing a site for all Tasmanians.

A touch of cricketing history too

The former Channel 9 commentary box from Bellerive Oval has been repurposed into the site's construction office and will also double as an information hub for site visitors. Suitable recognition to Richie, Bill, Tony, Ian and the team will be made!

What now?

The first stage of work on the Arm End site will involve environmental rehabilitation and quarry works, followed by construction of walking and cycling paths, the cafe and maintenance centre and delivering water to the site. It's anticipated the construction of the pipeline across the river will take about six months, coming after six months of planning.

The final eight months of the two year project will be the construction of the 18-hole, public golf course.

Once the site is operational, it will initially create 25 jobs. There could also be training opportunities for TasTAFE students in areas such as horticulture and we hope to work with students of the local primary school as well.

Clarence Mayor Alderman Doug Chipman, said he was keen to see the project go ahead as soon as possible. "It's going to improve the amenity for people wishing to use Arm End in terms of walking trails and hopefully it will even open up the prospect of a ferry service for that region," he said.

This journey is all going to be worth it with the end result being a significant project that will benefit many. Our vision was always, and remains, to deliver a place rather than just a golf course.



Preparing for Summer Bushfires cont'd

What about burn offs?

In the past many people have turned to their local fire brigade to undertake burn offs of the grass and bush on their property as a way of reducing the fire hazard on their own land. In some cases this was seen as a training opportunity for the brigade, but the objective of a burn off is elimination of the fuel by burning and the objective of fire training is extinguishing the fire, so there is little training benefit to be gained. This is not something that the South Arm Brigade undertakes these days.

Alternatives to burning off are preferable, but property owners that are physically capable, can burn small areas at a time on their own land that should be fully extinguished before lighting any further areas. You should have adequate personnel, sufficient water supplies at the ready and only burn when weather conditions are suitable. It is also advisable to notify your neighbours that you are about to conduct a burn as there are Environmental Regulations regarding smoke generation and restrictions on backyard burning on lots less than 2000m² including what you can and cannot burn. At all times you should always contact the Tasmania Fire Service on 1800 000 699 for advice and to register your burn with a start and expected finish time to avoid false call outs.

About Fire Permits

The Tasmania Fire Service will declare a Fire Permit Period when fire danger ratings are sufficient to cause risk if a fire occurs in the environment and restrictions are placed on the lighting of fires in the open.

Always contact the Tasmania Fire Service on 1800 000 699 and check the TFS website at www.fire.tas.gov.au for information and advice about safe burning and whether Fire Permits are required before planning any burn.

If a TOTAL FIRE BAN is declared then burning off is not permitted and all Fire Permits are revoked.



Rev Neil Vearing will be our locum for a while.


