Luke Young (1988 – 2009) was an inspirational young man, respected by all who knew him in South Arm and beyond. He was also a promising golfer who upheld the values of sportsmanship. His life was cut short by a tragic car accident that took his life and that of his mother Julie.

Mr Godfrey has been awarded a Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) for his service to veterans and their families. He is the co-editor of Gunners Vietnam 67/68, and The Turtle Times.

Mr Godfrey was also the recipient of the Police Certificate of Commendation "in recognition of the assistance given to persons in moving them to safety during the shooting tragedy which occurred on the 28th of April 1996".

Get ready for the bushfire season



With spring upon us, it is time to start thinking about getting our

bushfire survival plans ready. This year, we encourage everyone to take a moment to think about what has happened with the bushfire tragedies in Greece, North America, and the early start to the bushfire season in NSW.

This is a sad reminder of the critical importance of planning for the risk of bushfire. When you are developing, rehearsing and sharing your plan with your family, think about putting together an emergency kit. What do you need in it? What are the important things you can have ready to go? Items like:

- wallet/purse with money and credit cards
- medications, toiletries you might require
- phones and chargers
- emergency contact numbers/details
- birth certificates, bank details and other important documents
- photos and significant personal items
- water, food and clothes for the trip or if you get stuck somewhere
- first aid kit
- portable battery operated radio

• items for any pets including cat carriers, seat belts and leads for dogs, food, water and any medications for animals, and be sure your pet is wearing an identification tag.

It only takes a small amount of your time to assemble your kit and have it ready to go by your door, or even in the boot of your car. As we reflect on the stories of loss in Greece and North America, it is a reminder of how ferocious and unrelenting a bushfire can be. Help yourself, your family and your loved ones and get ready now.
