

Have your say on Council's coastal hazard management plans - Sun 6 Feb

Clarence City Council is seeking community input as it undertakes the process of updating its coastal hazard management plans for areas vulnerable to coastal erosion.

Residents from affected areas, including Pipe Clay Lagoon and Roches Beach are encouraged to complete an online survey as well as attend pop-up community information sessions, held in Cremorne and Lauderdale in early 2022.

This consultation follows last year's endorsement of council's Coastal Hazards Policy, which provides a consistent approach to the management of current and emerging coastal hazards on council-controlled land within the municipality.

The policy enables council to update coastal hazard management plans for key coastal areas, adopting a risk-based approach to managing coastal hazards that clarifies responsibilities regarding council-controlled land, Crown land and privately-owned land.

Business as usual for local Fire Brigade!



The year started with a day of total fire ban, keeping firefighters and residents on their toes. Despite the day not getting as hot or windy as predicted, a total fire ban enables resources to be focused on every report of fire before it develops.

The fire service, like all organisations, is managing numbers during this period of COVID and close contact isolations. With increased PPC and a vehicle that is pretty much hand sanitiser on wheels, it's business as usual once our pagers activate. You can help us by ensuring arriving crews (or 000) are informed of any COVID positive occupants so we can take necessary precautions. We will always put your life, property and the environment first, but also need to document any exposures. Personally speaking, I can't wait for the day that we stop talking about this!

Some residents may have seen us on Christmas Eve testing our pumps and hoses on the oval. This is part of our monthly testing of all equipment ensuring everything starts first time when we need it. It's also a great recruitment tool for new members.



Fire permit season has well and truly started, this means any fire larger than one metre needs a permit. These are provided for free by ringing 1800 000 699. A permit is a legal requirement that removes liability from you, whilst stipulating certain conditions that ensures the fire is safe. It also enable these burns to be monitored across the state, and prevents unnecessary false alarms.


