South Arm Community Bus is here!

After much anticipation, our very own brand new 11 seater Toyota HiAce passenger bus has been delivered to it's new home in South Arm. The South Arm Community Bus purchase was made possible thanks to a State Government grant initiated by Nic Street MP, for which we are very grateful.

SAPRA operates the Bus as a non for profit enterprise, with the fee (currently 65c/km) going to cover fuel and running costs only, and driven by volunteer drivers.



If you live on South Arm Peninsula, you can arrange regular or one-off access the bus. You could arrange a group trip for – retail therapy, lunch, coffee catchup, medical appointment, TMAG, Theatre Royal, golf, movies, Botanical Gardens, walking tracks... Just get your group together and go somewhere!

The Bus is also available for use by any community group on the South Arm Peninsula. SAPRA also plans to host social outings and shopping trips open to all – email Kirstie (saprsec@southarm.tas.au) to be notified of upcoming trips. program we can provide care from 8am – 6pm every school day.

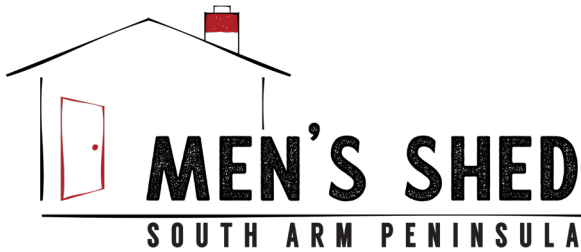

Joint training exercise



The volunteer fire brigades of the peninsula – South A Tasmania Fire Service Sandford – participated in joint training in February. Both brigades rely on each other, and on the support of neighbouring brigades during fire events. The Peninsula is a large area and has no access to pressurised hydrant systems. Joint training exercises are a great opportunity for brigades to meet and get a better understanding of the resources available to support a fire event.



The amount of information a fire fighter needs to retain is significant and the Tasmanian Fire Service teaches acronyms to help with the recollection of information.

For bush fire events, we make use of the acronym LACES – Lookout, Awareness, Communication, Escape Routes and Safety Zones. The joint training conducted during February offered a chance for the brigades to practice this in the local conditions of the Sandford area.

L - LOOKOUT is about understanding where the fire is and what it is doing. A lookout is posted to observe the fire behaviour and relay the information back to the crews to continue operating safely.

The brigades discussed that early warning of fire behaviour is especially important for fire crews in the Peninsula area with the ability for sea breezes or other changes to wind conditions to rapidly change the behaviour of fires and risk the safety of crews.

A - AWARENESS. Crews need to maintain a situational awareness of events as they evolve. The brigades inspected separate locations including fire trails around Sandford for access options for personnel and fire appliances (trucks) and to build awareness of potential hazards, such as fallen trees over fire trails, or trees that were damaged during a previous bushfire.

C - COMMUNICATION is paramount in any fire situation. Brigade crews need to keep each other up-to-date as the situation develops to ensure they are tackling the fire in the safest possible way.

E - ESCAPE ROUTES. Prior to fire fighters entering an area, crews identify as many as possible Escape Routes for evacuation in case fire behaviour becomes too risky for crews to remain.

S - SAFETY ZONES. A Safety Zone is a pre-planned safe refuge area for fire fighters and equipment.



Finally, the brigades completed awareness training on the different vehicles from each station on the Peninsula and demonstrated the operation of the pumping systems. With reticulated water unavailable for refilling appliances, we conducted draughting exercises to draw water from local waterways, relaying between each one.


The joint training was well-received by all who attended, and we are looking forward to future opportunities and potentially inviting other neighbouring brigades.

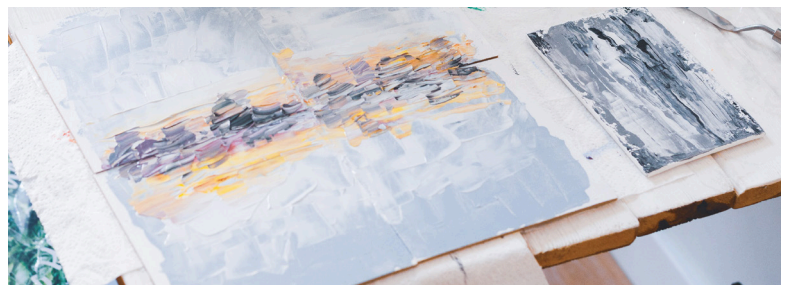

Big plant giveaway

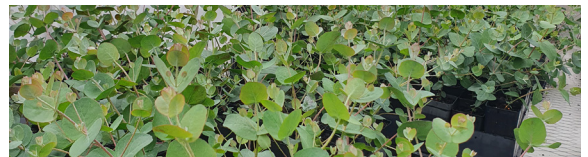

Update on the Sale of St Barnabas.

Without going back over old issues, the current situation is very positive and it is expected St Barnabas will be owned by the community within the next 2 months.

As you may be aware, the delay in the process of sale was caused initially by the issues surrounding COVID-19, and then by the action of the Howrah Parish in August 2021 to overturn the Diocese's decision regarding the sale.

Following the re-establishment of the sale process in late November 2021, several issues had to be revisited before our application for management of the cemetery would be accepted by the Tasmanian Government. It was necessary for the 3 officers of the Board of Management to re-apply for current Police checks, as those previously submitted had expired. An insurance cover note also had to be re-negotiated.

On the 7th March, our application to become Cemetery Managers, along with several other documents required by the Tasmanian Government Department was re-submitted, and accepted.

On Tuesday 8th March, The Board received from the Senior Policy and Project Officer, Policy and Intergovernmental Relations Division of the Department of Premier and Cabinet, an email advising us that our application appears in order and it will commence the process of obtaining the Regulator's approval. Under the Act, this should occur within 21 days.

Without pre-empting a timeline, and presuming no other obstacles delay the sale, it is likely that St Barnabas will officially become a Community Church, owned by the Board of Management of the Community Church of St Barnabas - South Arm Inc on behalf of the South Arm and Opossum Bay community by April/May 2022.
