Then the colours and magic appeared, resulting in a magnificent array of styles and subjects bursting off the walls. Beautifully woven baskets, fabulous craft and textile works and quirky pottery pieces also on display.

The Centre was busy all weekend with visitors admiring the works with some sales to help our artists (no hanging fees/commissions) and the Op Shop and History Room bustling with sales and great interest.

The crew from St Barnabas (now community-owned) again provided delicious morning and afternoon teas, successfully raising much-needed funds.

These two winter weekend displays were certainly a success on many levels and we'll be looking to repeat them should the Market take a winter break in 2023... or maybe even sooner!

Once again, a big thank you to Kirstie for her idea to support local artists and her hard work. Thanks also to Steve Hinton for his hanging skills, to the volunteers manning the Centre over the weekend and of course, the many talented artists for sharing their works.

Note: currently on display in the Centre are works from three local artists all of which are for sale. Artists will be rotated every 2-3 months to keep the walls alive with interesting and inspiring works.

Since our recordings started in 2009, we've only had 3 years where the rainfall for the first 8 months of the year have been 400mm. That was in 2009 with 448mm, in 2020 with 413mm and now in 2022 with 409mm. Lowest was in 2010 with just 189mm. — Geir

In Opossum Bay, we've had a total of 114 days of rain in the first 243 days this year. — Teresa

Car show success for Cancer Council

On 21 August, thanks to the generosity of Tony and Jude at the South Arm RSL & Community Club, Tom Herbert and I hosted a Car Show to raise money for our *Shitbox Rally* team.

Shitbox Rally is the largest community-led fundraiser for the Cancer Council in Australia and is now in its 13th year. To participate, each team must raise a minimum of \$5,000 but most teams raise well above this amount with the 2022 Spring rally target set at \$2,500,000 plus.

Originally planned for the weekend before, we were nervous about how that postponement would alter car and visitor numbers, however we were inundated with both. We were left speechless by how many beautiful cars made the trip down and with the generosity of all

the spectators (under no obligation to contribute). We raised \$1,273 from vehicle entry and raffle ticket sales alone.

Our sincere thanks to everybody who helped make this happen, the day would never have been such a success without every one of you.

We have both been touched by cancer with some family and loved friends surviving, whilst others sadly did not, with that loss felt every day. That's why we're fundraising.

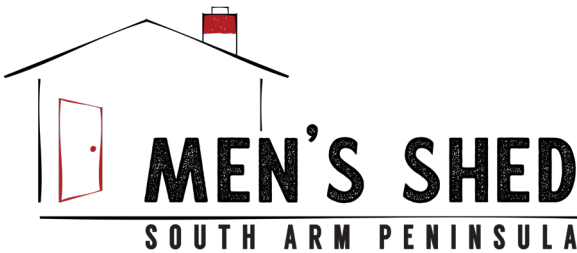
South Arm welcomes new store owners
