
#### CONTINUED P.1...CMMUNITY CHOIR






### FIRE DANGER LEVELS — Summer update

We are now in the middle of the fire season and the Brigade urges all residents and shack owners to be familiar with the fire danger levels.

During the bushfire season, fire danger ratings forecast for Tasmania will be available on the Bureau of Meteorology website, the Tasmania Fire Service website and on the weather page of Tasmania's daily newspapers. You should listen for warnings on ABC Radio or check the TFS website at www.fire.tas.gov.au to find out where fires are burning. Power supplies and phones are likely to fail in a bushfire. If power fails, listen to fire updates on your car radio.

During Fire Danger Levels of Catastrophic, Extreme, Severe, and Very High you should frequently check conditions outside your home. If smoke is blowing to-



wards you, a fire is approaching and you should leave immediately by a safe route, away from the fire. Please don't wait for an official warning. If ash or burning embers are landing in your yard, the fire is very close and it may be too late to leave. If this is the case, take shelter in your home. Fill your bath and all available containers with water, and actively defend your home by using the water to put out any parts of your home that catch fire. Alternatively and if time permits, go immediately to a nearby safe place.

Due to the hot and dry conditions there have been a number of days recently that were declared as Total Fire Ban days, and there will probably be more during summer. That means:-

- Tools and equipment that use a naked flame or generate sparks such as welding or grinding, must not be used in the open air.
- Camp fires, burn offs etc and any other fires including barbecues that use wood, charcoal or other solid fuel are banned, but gas and electric barbecues are permitted subject to the strict application of the conditions set out below.
- Gas and electric barbecues provided in public reserves/campsites may be used providing:
  - \* The barbecue is electric or gas fired and the barbecue is a fixed permanent structure.
  - \* Portable gas and electric barbecues may be used provided:
  - \* The barbecue is located within 20m of a permanent dwelling (mobile homes, caravans or tents are not classified as permanent dwellings).
- Additional conditions that apply to the use of portable electric and gas fired barbecues and barbecues in public reserves and campsites:
  - \* the area for 3m around and above the barbecue is completely cleared of flammable material, an adult is in attendance at all times, a tap with hose connected is ready for use and at least 10 liters of water is on hand in case of emergency.

### **Arm End Public Recreation Reserve** PROJECT UPDATE

The Proponents of Arm End Public Recreation Reserve wishes the communities of the South Arm Peninsular a wonderful and safe 2016 New Year.

Thank you for your continued support and interest in our project, which remains on track to begin construction in 2016. We are very grateful for the broad community support for reviving this public resource.


Following the original local council approval that was granted in 2012, we submitted a revised Development Application that was based on our ongoing community consultation and the site improvements gained through further site master planning. In October, 2015, the Clarence City Council approved our second Development Application with Aldermen voting overwhelming in support - 9-1.

Since then, Arm End Public Recreation Reserve has unfortunately been engaged with Resource Management Planning Appeals Tribunal process initiated by local residents. The RMPAT hearing is set for February 16, 2016. We believe that a resolution via the RMPAT process will finally allow for a start on site, continue to improve the overall project, and address the appellants concerns based around visual impacts, disturbance to residents, and our site master plan.

We feel the project represents a significant opportunity to demonstrate the wider value that a mixed public use space can bring to the community, including the rehabilitation of the landscape.

We believe that when complete, the Arm End Public Recreation Reserve will provide the local and broader Tasmanian community, as well as interstate and international visitors, with a low impact, environmentally sustainable, dynamic and fun-living site that will be enjoyed by all while providing long-term employment opportunities.
