BUSHFIRE READY: A NEARBY SAFE PLACE

A nearby safer place is a place of last resort for people during bushfire emergencies. If you have no bushfire survival plan or your plan has failed, a nearby safer place may be your last resort when there is an imminent threat of bushfire.

A nearby safer place is a building or space that may give some protection from the lifethreatening effects of radiant heat during a bushfire. These may include town centres, ground level water (eg rivers, in-ground pools, dams), or large open areas (eg beaches, ploughed or green fields, golf courses, well-maintained sports fields or parks).

ARM END PROJECT UPDATE January 2017

Arm End Multi-use Public Recreation Reserve is currently investigating suitable sustainable energy options with the intention to power the majority of the site through renewable energy, including the extensive irrigation system for the world-class, Public Golf Course and café.

Our site's water servicing options are still being refined. While this has taken some time to organise, we are confident that we have investigated all options thoroughly to ensure future water security.

We recently hosted members of Coastal Volunteers Australia, who planted 800 Allocasuarina Verticillate - Drooping Sheoak - a dominate coastal tree, propagated from seed harvested locally by the Understory Network.

Arm End is developing a Memorandum of Understanding with CVA to put in place an ongoing relationship that will significantly help with the sites revegetation and rehabilitation.

To all our supporters, thank you for your patience; it will definitely be worth it as we create Tasmania's first public, sustainable multi-use recreation reserve - a beautiful outdoor place for everyone to enjoy.

We will be creating sustainable habitats for our native fauna, as well as the extensive bird life which thrives on Arm End and its surrounds. Our aim is to start the site environmental rehabilitation program in late summer 2017, which will signal the on-ground start of the overall project. We are continuing to maintain the existing walking paths and fire breaks. Please enjoy a safe, peaceful and fun summer season.

THE PENINSULA TERRAIN... ...a wonderland for snakes!

Amazing? Or does something long and scaly scare the hell out of you? Either way our climate, dry bushlands, grassy fields, and coastal nooks create a wonderland for snakes. Don't slither away and hide under a rock—there are a number of things you can do around your property that may...politely discourage uninvited visitors:

- Keep grass short and the lower branches of trees and bushes trimmed off the ground where possible.
- Clean up building materials around the yard, such as piles of timber, bricks or sheets of corrugated iron.
- Keep rubbish and compost areas tidy.
- Be aware that chicken sheds and aviaries attract mice and rates which attract snakes—good time to make any repairs.
- On bigger blocks, put containers of water around the edge of your property to eliminate the need for snakes to come close to the house to drink. Very often they are simply hot and thirsty and will seek water.
- When working outside wear long pants, thick socks, boots and gloves for a little extra protection.

Snakes generally will not bite unless trodden on or backed into a corner. If you do get bitten seek immediate medical attention call 000. If a pet is bitten they will also need immediate veterinary attention.

If you see one, leave it alone and call Reptile Rescue Tasmania on 0400 502 403-they offer a rescue and relocation service on the east coast. Visit their website www.reptilerescuetasmania.com.au
