Peninsula History Cruises

The South Arm Peninsula History Group and SAPRA are excited to announce that in conjunction with the Motor Yacht Club of Tasmania (MYCT), history tours on board the M.L. Egeria on Sunday 26 March 2023.

The tours will be from Opossum Bay Jetty to Gellibrand Point via Mary Ann Bay, then to the Iron Pot and return, duration 2 hours. Tours are 9.30am, 11.45am and 2pm. Commentary on board will be provided.

Number of passengers for each tour is limited to 25. Price of a ticket is \$40 per person.

There will also be an opportunity to take a trip on the Egeria from Opossum Bay Jetty soon after 4pm to MYCT. Enjoy a drink at the bar at MYCT before travelling back to the Peninsula from MYCT on the new South Arm Community Bus.Number of passengers for the trip to MYCT and return by Community Bus is limited to 11. Price of a ticket is \$30 per person (does not include drinks at the MYCT bar).

Due to very limited car parking at the Opossum Bay Jetty, the new South Arm Peninsula Community Bus will be available to pick up passengers from South Arm and Opossum Bay for transport to the jetty and return. Ride on the bus will be a gold coin donation and includes the return trip. Pickup points and times will be advised after bookings have been finalised.

Guests are very welcome to bring their own food and refreshments.

Bookings will be available at https://www.trybooking. com/CEODN from 1st February, 2023. Price of tickets includes 50c Trybooking fee. The MYCT is home to the Egeria, a classic antique vessel built from Huon Pine and Teak in 1941. The 18.9 metre Egeria served as a Naval Auxiliary launch during World War II and has since carried many distinguished guests including visiting royalty and Tasmanian Governors. Authentically presented, the Egeria is a unique part of the River Derwent heritage.

This is a unique opportunity for you and your family and guests to see the Peninsula from the water and learn some of the history in style on board the Egeria.

If the tours are fully booked out, more may be organised at some future date. A decision to postpone the tours will be made the night before should the weather forecast look unsuitable for a comfortable and safe cruise.

Sparking conversations that matter

The bushfire season started with many parts of Tasmania experiencing the highest spring rainfall on record, but the threat of bushfire is still present and growing as the warm weather continues. Parts of Tasmania are particularly vulnerable to bushfire, including areas in South Arm.

A new bushfire resilience project called Sparking Conversations, Igniting Action is working with communities within Clarence and the other Greater Hobart Council areas to prepare for bushfire. The two year pilot project aims to help people understand the bushfire risks in their area and what they can do to better prepare their homes, families, and communities.

The team from Sparking Conversations, Igniting Action (pictured above) is out meeting residents in Sandford, which is a bushfire-prone area that could be threatened by direct flames or embers if a bushfire were to occur.

The project will seek to connect neighbours in Sandford so they can prepare for bushfire as a community.

Well, 2022 turned out to be a wet year for Cremorne, the second wettest year we have recorded and just about 12mm short of our 2009 record of 698mm. — Geir

Opussum Bay finished off the year with a magnificent 633.7mm which is the most rain we've had in a year since 2011 when we had 645.1mm. — Teresa

South Arm Fire Brigade

Most people associate volunteer firefighters with the huge effort that goes into containing bush fires each year. Whilst a lot of our training does focus on this bushfire fighting, our volunteers need to be ready for any emergency. The volunteers at South Arm, Sandford and Lauderdale are also trained and equipped to deal with any structure or vehicle fire, and regularly train in smoke filled buildings, practicing search and rescue techniques, extinguishment and salvage. Our volunteers are also often first on scene at car accidents and chemical spills, always with the aim of protecting the public, property and the environment. Our main tool for many of these emergencies is water, so if you have a water tank required for firefighting purposes, please ensure it is full, accessible and clearly marked.


Permit season has well and truly started. This means before lighting any fire larger than 1m, you are required to ring the fire service to get a permit. This ensures basic fire safety criteria are considered, and fires will not escape and get out of control. There are a number of



permit officers at every fire station that can inspect what you are planning to burn, provide advise, and issue a permit if feasible. The number to ring is 1800 000 699.

Whilst we had a pretty wet year last year, the ground has already dried and the vegetation is very flammable. Don't underestimate how dangerous fire is, and always call 000 if you see a unattended fire.

There has been a slight change to how fire danger ratings are relayed to the public. This is a result of years of studies and research, and the need for a nationwide simple system. There are now only four categories:

This fortnightly trip is also planned for **Tuesdays: 21 February, 7 March** and **21 March**. If successful the service will be ongoing so if you can, please support this service.

The Bus carries 11 people (plus the volunteer driver) and is also available for private trips. Get a group of local friends together and head out to walk and talk, to feast and sip, absorb some culture or take in event – eg the Wooden Boat Festival.

Past trips have included walking groups, lunch outings, church outings, family birthday celebrations, vineyards, shopping, medical appointments, festivals and gardens. Cremorne Bowls Club and Sandford Cricket Club have also used the bus to transport their teams to games.


