CALVERTON HALL, OVAL AND TENNIS COURT: A COMMUNITY HUB

The Hall and the Oval started as the Cricket Pavilion and Oval. The cricket club had regular matches for years and the club belonged to the Clarence District Cricket Association. The club folded in the late sixties and then started again in the late seventies when there were two teams—South Arm and Opossum Bay. Once again it folder due to lack of interest. The books containing details of all matches played were given to the Bellerive Cricket Museum at Blundstone Oval where they can be seen if the museum is open.

The two properties together with the tennis court were given to the Clarence City Council in 1985 on the clear understanding that they would always be managed by the community. The Calverton Hall Association was formed and leases the area from the Council.

This Association raises funds to keep everything in the Hall in order. In the last few years nearly \$100,000 has been spent on the Hall and the tennis court. A dressing room was added to the Hall and the kitchen renovated. The tennis court was resurfaced with supergrass and a new fence erected. A BBQ was installed with funds from the Hall Association, SAPRA and the Council. It is used quite often by people in the area as well as visitors.

Although we no longer have an official cricket team there are still games played occasionally. The Oval is used for soccer training for the younger children one night each week and for school activities when required. The Boot Camp uses it regularly. The Clarence Ladies Football Club uses it for preseason training and the Clarence Football Club has trained there. Car Boot sales are held on the oval on market days.

The Hall is used regularly by the Craft Group, Tai Chi, the Bridge Club, Indoor Bowls, birthday parties, a children's holiday club which also uses the oval, wedding receptions and funeral wakes. The Apple Islander Caravan Club has a weekend at the hall and the oval. There is a Soup and Sandwich lunch every month which raises money for charities. People are brought in buses from the Rest Homes to these lunches.

Every year a Melbourne Cup lunch is held organised by some very energetic ladies. The Scouts have a sleepover on ANZAC Day. There have been some family reunions too. Once a year Piggery Productions puts on a Revue which over the years has raised much money for the school.

CERT: South Arm Update

Firstly on behalf of the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) I would like to extend a big thank you to the wider community for the continued support shown to our group. As volunteers we all find it extremely rewarding to provide first response to those in medical need within the community, but whether it is through fund raising or a simple thank you when we bump into someone it really is appreciated! More specifically a heartfelt thanks to a group of our local ladies, who raised money last year at a Melbourne Cup Luncheon. Ladies we were most overwhelmed by your kind donation and will keep you posted as to what we use the money for. Past donations have allowed us to purchase additional equipment including additional torches, better quality stethoscopes and traction splints.

Did you know for the period July 2014 through to October 2014 there were 63 calls to triple zero from the South Arm and surrounding areas? This is an average of around 15 calls per month. So if there were any doubts about the need for the CERT service I think these figures tell the story!

Currently we are in desperate need for more volunteers. Ambulance Tasmania provides all the training so there is absolutely no requirement to have previous medical or first aid background. Not only do you get an opportunity to support your community but gain lifelong skills, which can and do save lives. Please contact me or speak to any of the volunteers should you have questions or just want to understand a little more about what we do.

I hope that the Easter break is an enjoyable time with family and friends and the community stays safe and well.

Consultation on the Draft South Arm Oval Master Plan closes on Wednesday 8 April. To date Council has received a large number of responses and commends the local community for engagement with the consultation program. After April 8, Council officers will collate all the responses received and present the outcomes and findings to a Clarence... a brighter place



Council Workshop for discussion and review by Alderman. Following the outcomes of these discussions, Council officers will then compile an Agenda Item with recommendations for any revisions, additions or amendments to the Draft South Arm Oval Master Plan. This Agenda item will be considered for adoption by Council at a formal Council Meeting and will result in the development of the final version of the South Arm Oval Master Plan.

The dates for these Council Workshops and Meetings are yet to be confirmed. Timing will be dependent on the final number of responses received and the time required to collate the data. It is also dependent on the current program and availability to book time to present the findings at Council Meetings. Council will endeavour to keep the local community informed and up to date with the process as it unfolds.

SCHOOL TERMS

First term has flown by and the kids will be well into their school holidays when this is delivered.

Second terms starts on Monday 20 April 2015 and finishes Friday 3 July 2015.

CHICKEN, SWEET POTATO AND FETA BAKE

(This one is gluten free)

- Mix 250g feta crumbled and 3 or 4 handfuls of spinach (fresh or frozen but if frozen squeeze out the excess moisture).
- Cut 2 large sweet potatoes (about 1kg) into slices—boil or steam until tender.
- Cook 4 chicken breasts in a frying pan and thinly slice
- Cook 1 large white onion (chopped finely) and 2 tsp fresh thyme. When soft add to the feta mix.
- Cook 1/4 cup sour cream, 1/2 cup chicken stock, 2 tsp corn flour, 1 tbs water until the mixture boils and thickens.
- Then layer all the ingredients in an ovenproof dish and pour cream mixture over the top. Season with salt and pepper if desired.
- Sprinkle with your favourite cheese and bake uncovered in a moderately hot oven for about 30 mins or until cheese browns.

Tip: You can swap onion for leek or even sweet potato for pumpkin!



HISTORY & HERITAGE WORLD WAR 1

Following on from the story about Horace Calvert in the last newsletter much more information has come to light about Horace which will be covered at a later date. We have read about the many others throughout the Clarence Municipality and the east coast of Tasmania who enlisted to join the forces during World War 1. The men began their training at the Army Camp set up at Claremont while others went into Camp at Pontville. The daily newspapers reported the names of those men as they enlisted from May 1916 and the following six months. During that period they soon reached a total of 2000 men in training at the Camp. This number reduced when the 40th Battalion departed from Hobart aboard HMAT Berrima on 1 July 1916. At the time there were a number of German descendants and families living in Tasmania, these were interned at Claremont and later moved to Bruny Island. We all know or have read the many stories of men and what they experienced in battles such as the landing at Gallipoli and the harsh conditions experienced plus the war that followed in France and Belgium. Australians were moved by the stories of their troops' with more men going to enlist, but after months of combat the whole exercise at Gallipoli was abandoned. Looking at the other sides of War I have just read a book "The Bad Boys" by Fran Read. It covers the stories of the men who enlisted from Runnymede, Buckland, Wielangta, Orford and Triabunna with many photos and letters of those who wrote home to their families. This book covers the experiences of life and the health associated while in training in these other countries prior to entering the areas of war. As we are aware unfortunately many did not return home, of those who did the welcome home at the end of the war is well documented in this book. As the war happened 100 years ago it is no wonder that many of these volunteers who enlisted came from a farming background throughout the country towns. Tasmania then was still under a way of development with settlers who had struggled to establish a business or farms as so desired.




MAY COMMUNITY MARKET



WATER TANK HEALTH

I recently saw a CSIRO link/article float by on the Cremorne playgroup email and it's worth a read. The article is a timely reminder that water tanks are not "set-and forget" household utilities they need to be in tip top shape and some regular checks will keep your tanks in good health.

There are 5 tips for maintaining rainwater tanks:

- 1. Get your mind (and the leaves) out of the gutter every 3 months.
- 2. Mozzie mesh every 3 months
- Spend some quality time getting to know your water quality every 6
 months
- 4. Pump it real good every 6 months
- 5. It's time to desludge

SOUTH ARM FIRE BRIGADE: AS THE WEATHER

COOLS DOWN BE VIGILANT

The fire permit period has recently ceased but the vegetation in the area is still dry enough for fires to get out of control and spread. We are about to install



our new 'Fire Permits Required' sign, which will be permanently placed on the main road between the RSL and the Fort Direction Road junction. In the non-permit season the sign will display a fire safety message.

We have had a quiet season so far this year, with the brigade recently called to a vegetation fire at Musk Road and a shed fire. Although traditionally the bushfire season has been the busiest time for fire-fighters, in Tasmania autumn and winter often prove to be more dangerous, with significantly more house fires, and unfortunately, some fire-related deaths.

Wood heaters are always a potential for house fires and need to be serviced every year. Clothes should not be placed to dry any closer than 2 metres from the heater.

Smoke alarms do save lives, but the batteries should be changed every a year when daylight saving finishes, this year that will be on 5 April, so please don't forget to replace your battery.
