The South Arm RSL Sub-Branch Inc. will conduct a Dawn and an 11.00am Service on ANZAC Day, Tuesday 25 April 2017.

The Dawn Service will be conducted at the Lone Pine Memorial, Fort Direction commencing at 6.00 am.

The Main Service will be conducted at the South Arm Cenotaph on 25 April 2017. Form-up for the march for the Main Service will commence at 10.20 am on the corner of South Arm Road and Calverton Place. The march to the Cenotaph, along South Arm Road, will commence at 10.45am.

South Arm Road from Calverton Place to the Cenotaph and to Calverton Lane, as well as part of Jetty Road, will be closed from 10.20 am to 12.45pm.

Emergency traffic will be diverted from South Arm Road through Calverton Place and Calverton Lane link.

MYTHBUSTING – DON'T BE IN THE RED

MYTH – I don't need to prepare my property for a bushfire because emergency services will come and assist me.





Tasmania Fire Service

BUSTED – they probably won't. If you haven't made your property defendable, valuable resources will be directed to where they can help the most.

In catastrophic bushfires residents without a bushfire survival plan have died because they stayed to defend with minimal resources or left it too late to leave and have been caught in the oncoming fire front. The enquiry into deaths in the 2009 Black Saturday fires resulted in an Australia- wide shift of a "Shared Responsibility-Government, Communities, and Individuals".

As a resident it is now your responsibility to have a plan and not wait around for emergency services. Whether it's leave early or stay and defend you can prepare your property to minimise the impact of bushfire on the building – create a defendable space with hazard management zones, ember proof, have water sources and areas for fire trucks to enter and be able to turn around.

If you want fire fighters to come to your property and safely assist you in defending it from a bushfire then these hazard management tasks are critical. Why?

Firefighters give properties a rating – it's called Bushfire Triage - according to their level of 'likely defendability'. This depends on things like weather condition, fuels, fire behaviour, building features, defendable space, property access and water supplies for firefighting. It also means limited firefighting resources will be sent safely to where they are most effective.

Triage categories are:

* Undefendable RED: firefighters will not defend the building, it does not have sufficient defendable space. The building is unlikely to survive a bushfire even if civilians and/or firefighters stay to defend it. All who stay face a high risk of harm.

The South Arm RSL Sub-Branch Committee continues to work hard at fund raising activities to raise much needed capital required for the on-going development of the Memorial Park. The Park is a gift to the community in honour of all Service Men and Women who fought and died in all wars & conflicts.

During the next few months, a number of exciting and significant enhancements will be made to the Memorial Park. Including a large historical piece of Military equipment that was used extensively throughout the Vietnam War will be delivered and placed on permanent display. * **Defendable with firefighter assistance ORANGE**: firefighters may defend the building. It has defendable space, can be accessed safely and occupiers are absent or occupiers have advised that they will stay and defend it. Firefighters have assessed that the occupiers will need assistance. Any additional resources or water required may be provided by firefighters. All who stay face a marginal risk of harm if properly prepared and equipped.

* **Defendable without firefighter assistance GREEN**: firefighters will not need to defend the building. It has defendable space and firefighters are confident that occupiers who are planning to stay have the necessary resources to defend it safely. All who stay face a minimal risk of harm if properly prepared and equipped.

A triaged RED undefendable property will not be actively defended by firefighters; so prepare and be safe - don't be in the RED.

In coming winter months prepare your property in readiness for next fire season. Write a bushfire survival plan and make sure you have considered contingencies of varying factors, such as a leave early plan even though you plan to stay and defend.

PUMPKIN CARE

Are you nursing your pumpkins to enter into the 'Biggest Pumpkin Competition'?

Peter Cundall says:

"The longer you can restrain yourself from picking your pumpkins, the better will be the flavour, and the longer they will keep. If you have the willpower to leave them unpicked, even until the first light frost, you won't regret it. But don't make the same mistake as I did a couple of seasons ago. I miscalculated the sharpness of the frost. The result was heartbreaking. I lost about a third of my pumpkins within a few weeks of storing, when they started to rot at the point where they had been frost-bitten. So learn from my blunders.

These days, to make sure they keep longer, I leave them to ripen for a few days in the sun, covering them only at night with a little dry grass or straw. The sun toughens up the skin beautifully, and because I also leave about half a metre of vine still attached, the stalk dries up too. Resist the temptation to carry your pumpkins and squash by their 'handles'. The withered stalk is really quite fragile, and once broken off it leaves the poor things with nothing to look forward to but a short and rotten life."

RECIPES — a pumpkin theme!

Spicy pumpkin seeds

Wash the seeds left over from trimming pumpkin and scrape off any fibre. Dry the seeds naturally or overnight in the oven on the very lowest setting, then roast at 200C for 15 minutes until they are a deep gold. Season with sea salt and 1 tsp toasted cumin seeds.

Wedges

Cut thick slices/wedges dust with flour and fry or roast. Toss crisped sage leaves and parmesan and don't forget the salt and pepper.

In antipasto

Sprinkle sliced, cold baked pumpkin (basically your left overs) with olive oil and a splash of red wine vinegar and add to a antipasto.
