



CHARACTERS OF SOUTH ARM PAST

As far as extraordinary characters go, we know the South Arm Peninsula has a few these days, but apparently it has always been thus! Historian James Parker and our own Maurice Potter combined their research talents to share stories of people past at a recent event put on by the Clarence Plains Tranmere Land & Coast Care group as part of the Tasmanian Heritage Festival.

On a stunning South Arm day, the group stood looking across Arm End and heard about the Gellibrands as well as some of the early convicts and settlers then headed to the churchyard at St Barnabas. Here Maurice explained his family's long local history and all pondered the lives of those resting around us. A particularly sad story was laid bare on the headstone of Janet Alomes who died in 1864, but you'll have to visit our historic little churchyard to discover that and other stories for yourself!

Whilst the delicious lunch of soup and scones was being devoured at the Community Centre, James put on a slide show of historic pictures and answered many questions from his keen audience.

A special treat was still in store as the group headed to Fort Direction. The story of the Lone Pine Memorial as well as the "fair dinkum" Horace Calvert of WW1 were told under skies much brighter than the usual Dawn Service!

The incredible lives of the Iron Pot lighthouse keepers and their families were next to be shared along with some photos that still left all wondering "how on earth did that big house fit on the island?". A good photo opportunity of Iron Pot looking glorious set in blue seas too.

An event enjoyed by all with thanks to James, Maurice, Lorraine Redway and Pene Marshall for their stories, food, organisation and for arranging such fantastic weather!

MANAGE YOUR FLAMMABLE VEGETATION OVER WINTER

We know the only fires top of mind in winter are those to warm our homes but it's a great time to get ready for a bushfire and start making your property safe. Use this time to plan and prepare for the next bushfire season as doing a little bit over this time can make a big difference when spring comes around. From June to September you could:



- ♦ Clear flammable items/ liquids and rubbish away from your home and use non-flammable building materials.
- ♦ Move woodpiles away from the house.
- ♦ Ember proof gaps greater than 2mm in buildings with metal screens or putty.
- ♦ Regularly clean the gutters, cut long grass and get rid of leaves, twigs and bark.

TANGARA TRAIL CHECK IN WITH THE RULES AND ENJOY!



USE VOICE TO ALERT OTHERS
Especially when approaching a horse so they're not startled by your presence.

CONTROL YOUR DOG
Keep it under effective control and restrain it on a lead or by the collar if you encounter a horse, bike or walkers.

GIVE WAY TO HORSES
Horse riders have priority, then walkers; MTB riders give way to both. As a courtesy, walkers may step aside on narrow sections of track to allow bikes to pass.

CONTROL YOUR SPEED
Ride your horse or bike at a controlled speed. Slow down for corners and blind spots.

SLOW WHEN PASSING
To the speed of other users. Prepare to stop if necessary.

WEAR A HELMET
Wear an approved equestrian or bike helmet.

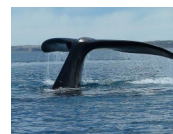

In July the Church will be celebrating 125 years since it's Consecration in 1892. In the early days the small settlement of South Arm revolved around the Church, which was faithfully supported and maintained by the few families who lived and farmed on the Peninsula. It fulfilled a major role with numerous Baptisms, Marriages and funerals, of which there were many, including convict labourer's and their families. The Church provided fellowship, and comfort in times of loss and distress, which is still its role today. The people were not as affluent as we are today, and were more aware of their dependence on God, as indeed we are today. We would love to have more people join the congregation, and of course all denominations are welcome. Easter services and celebrations were well attended.

There will be a reminder board outside the shop on Church Sundays—now the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month at 4:00pm, followed by a meal. You would all be very welcome.

RECIPE—PULLED PORK

- 1.5-2kg leg of pork (remove all fat)
- 1/2 cup tomato sauce
- 2 teaspoons brown sugar
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce
- 2 teaspoons marmalade
- 1 tablespoon red wine vinegar
- 2 tablespoons Dion mustard
- 1 1/2 tablespoons sweet chilli sauce
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tablespoon rum (any sort)
- 3 cloves of garlic, crushed
- 1 teaspoon salt or chicken stock powder
- 1/2 teaspoon coffee powder or granules

Place all ingredients in the slow cooker. Cover with the lid and cook for 4-5 hours on high on 8-10 hours on low until the pork is very tender. Lift out and remove any bones.

Shred meat with two forks and return to the cooker to cook for 20 minutes more on high. Add salt and pepper to taste.

Service in warm fresh bread rolls, or as a filling in wraps (goes well with shredded purple cabbage). Yum!
