## Bushfire Ready Neighbourhoods coming to South Arm and Sandford

Bushfire Ready Neighbourhoods is a targeted program that works intensively with high risk communities. Before you say "South Arm – high risk, surely not?", here's why both Sandford and South Arm have been identified as high bushfire risk. Contributing factors to assessment include:



- bushfire history
- geography, vegetation types and fuel loads
- potential to have bushfires that burn out of control and impact on people
- weather
- · access/egress of traffic travelling in an emergency
- vulnerable groups and residential locations being isolated
- · fire agencies capability to respond quickly
- seasonal impacts on population
- communication issues such as black spots of internet/phone/radio".

Lesley King of Tasmania Fire Services Bushfire-Ready Neighbourhoods program will be at the September South Arm Community Market to share information with the community and get your thoughts on the fire preparedness of our area. She will then meet with the SAPRA Committee to discuss ideas on how the program could work for the Sandford and South Arm areas.



If you are elderly, suffering from ill health or find yourself struggling to cook meals every day, you may be eligible for




assistance through our frozen meals program.

#### **Bushfire Ready (cont. p.1)**

The Bushfire-Ready Neighbourhoods program focuses on building a shared responsibility approach to bushfire preparedness through recognising that individuals, communities and the Tasmania Fire Service all play important parts.



The program's aim is to build resilience and capacity in bushfire prevention, preparedness and response in Tasmanian communities at risk to bushfire through a sustainable community development approach, by engaging people in various activities to build their knowledge of their risk and how to improve their bushfire resilience.

Some of the community bushfire activities with neighbourhoods may include information sessions, survival planning workshops, phone tree development, field days, bushfire rehearsals and property assessments.

## PRESENCE AND CONNECTION WORKSHOP

30 September & 1 October, South Arm Community Centre

'Presence and connection – an introduction to Hakomi' is a two day workshop, to be held at the South Arm Community Centre on Friday 30 September and Saturday 1 October. The presenter is Dr Karen Baikie, a Hakomi therapist, consultant clinical psychologist and Hakomi teacher who lives in Sydney. This is the first Hakomi workshop to be offered in Tasmania.

Hakomi mindfulness-based psychotherapy draws from 20<sup>th</sup> century psychotherapy methods (especially Gestalt and somatic approaches), Buddhist (especially Zen) mindfulness traditions, and contemporary neuroscience (especially neuroplasticity, attachment theory, arousal states).

I am helping to promote this workshop, as I live in South Arm, and attended three Hakomi mindfulness-based psychotherapy workshops on the mainland last year - they were simply wonderful. Hakomi workshops are typically attended by psychologists, counsellors, pastoral carers and a sprinkling of interested others. There are no prerequisites for attending the workshop and certificates recording professional development hours are provided.

The Hakomi approach works in mindfulness, from a state of loving kindness. Hakomi workshops involve experiential exercises, practising Hakomi techniques, reflection and theory.

#### ARM END PROJECT UPDATE — July 2016

Thank you for your continued support and interest in the project, which remains on track to begin construction in the coming 12 months. Our progress to date:

- In October 2015, we welcomed the Clarence City Council approving a revised Development Application with a 9-1 vote (the original DA was lodged in June 2015).
- The DA was based on our ongoing community consultation and the improvements gained from further site planning. We are very grateful for the very broad, community support for renewing this public resource.
- The DA process then saw the project engaged in a Resource Management Planning Appeals Tribunal process.
- The RMPAT hearing resulted in the CCC permit being reissued in late April 2016 with grounds of appeal being dismissed by the RMPAT Tribunal. The RMPAT appeal process delayed by around 9 months the project progress, but was worth the extra time to achieve a fair community outcome.

Arm End Public Recreation Reserve believes that the resolution from the RMPAT process will continue to allow the project to confidently progress towards an onsite construction start.

The project team is now able to progress with the task of resolving and finalising a reliable and sustainable water servicing supply. We are progressing with solutions that allow for a sustainable benefit to the environment and future

A sign will soon be erected onsite to provide information to community members and other visitors to Arm End.

We have recently completed a final site-wide environmental, weed management and rehabilitation plan. Other outstanding stakeholder obligations, including councils' engineering and permit conditions, can now also confidently be finalised and secured.

When complete, the Arm End Public Recreation Reserve will provide the local and broader Tasmanian community, as well as interstate and international visitors, with a spectacular public site that can be enjoyed for future generations, by all walks of life. Arm End will provide long-term employment opportunities, and be a public-private land rehabilitation that transforms Arm End into a valued and sustainable community recreational and environmental tourism resource.

A gift, just of their own, makes an enormous difference for a child who has never owned anything. Boxes from the St Barnabas community and beyond go mainly to Cambodia. Cambodia has not yet recovered from the Phol Pot regime, when thousands of people lost their lives for political reasons and all places of learning were closed or bulldozed. Tasmanian state manager, Jenny Baxter, went to Cambodia to help distribute boxes to the children last year, and saw firsthand just how much children need help of this kind. 



Crime Stoppers is an independent, nonprofit, community organisation that assists and supports crime-solving by providing a safe, confidential way to report crime. It's separate to the police and provides an alternative avenue to report crime.

Please, help keep our community safe and report information that may otherwise not reach Tasmania Police. Here's some tips and info:



- **Report information as soon as possible:** don't wait until your memory fades and details become sketchy because it's quite often the small details that are crucial in solving crime.
- Your information is more important to than your identity to Crime Stoppers.
- You speak confidentially to an experienced operator who compiles a report using the information you provide.
- Calls are not recorded and there is no phone call ID. The information you provide is then forwarded to Tasmania Police for investigation, anonymously.

Your piece of information might just add to other pieces to complete a crime jigsaw and see a perpetrator held accountable.
