



SOUTH ARM PENINSULA COMMUNITY GARDEN IS UP AND GROWING!

After holding an initial planning meeting in July, at which we were inspired by Nell Smit of the Tarooma Community Garden, we held our first working bee on Saturday 16 August.

What a great day it was! We turned up at the centre (with assorted garden implements, donated plants, piles of old newspapers and trailer-loads of mulch, compost and enthusiasm) and worked and laughed our way through the morning - digging, weeding, composting, mulching and planting. We put in a wind-break along the fence leading to the car-park (black-wood, hop bushes, assorted hardy natives, lavender, a bay tree, thyme) as well as planting two beds of green manure crop to improve the soil in an area destined to grow potatoes and pumpkins. We've since planted rhubarb and dahlias to fill in some gaps.

Two new brigade recruits are in the process of completing their basic training and should be operational by the start of the summer bushfire season. Training is always the second Tuesday in the month, commencing at 7.30 pm at South Arm Fire Station.

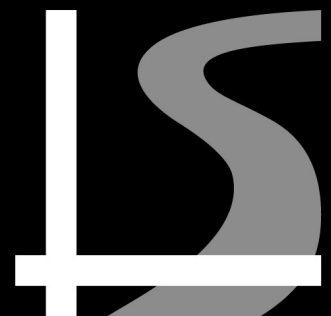

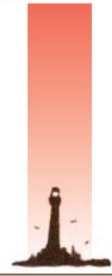

HISTORY AND HERITAGE

We continue the story of Gellibrand...

Having viewed the history how the Rev Joseph Tice Gellibrand developed the farm at Omokoroa Point Tauranga with help from the relatives Crapp Family, it was a pleasure for us to walk through the Park lands, viewing the trees that have stood all those years. Quite a few are the same species Oak and Gum that we have here in Tasmania along with others that Gellibrand had picked seeds from during his world travels and planted in the area. It was nice to see how the Historical Group have been able to develop the park lands, and have now laid out tracks throughout. In recognition of Gellibrand one of the trees he planted has now been trimmed and with the help of a chain saw artist there now stands a sculpture beautifully carved from the tree of Joseph Gellibrand. At the base of the stature is another carving of two boats that Gellibrand owned embedded into the trunk and protected by a glass encased wring. This work was organised by Murray Crapp member of the historical group and funded by local Councils, it is now known as the "Warwick Lilley, Murray Crapp Gellibrand sculpture". Warwick Lilley was the chain saw artist and Murray Crapp completed the colouring and sculptured the boats and encased them in glass. As we have several photos from our visit to Omokoroa relating to Gellibrand I will display them on market day at the Community centre.

Pauline and I thank Colin and Shirley Pettigrew for arranging our day in their local history of Omokoroa Point. It all came about from a meeting with them when they visited South Arm in 2009 looking for the history of Gellibrand's here. Colin retired from teaching and has since put a lot of work into writing history and production into DVD's from the time of the Maori wars through to the changes in Omokoroa today.
