making boating better

With a coast line longer than NSW and Victoria combined, it's little wonder that interest in boating in Tasmania is enormous. We have over 30,500 registered recreational boats plus all those not requiring registration. 1 in 17 Tasmanians has a registered boat and 1 in 8 Tasmanians has a boat licence. Add in all the "off the beach" type craft not requiring registration and maybe 1 in 7 Tasmanians have a means of getting on the water. Compare this to NSW where 1 in 32 have a registered boat!

Since 2000, registrations have increased by huge 84% meaning many are getting onto the water with little experience. Experienced or not, it's essential that everyone takes time to prepare before each trip on the water.

Checking the weather is paramount to having a great day out. Always check the weather on the day you're heading out, don't rely on last night's TV forecast – we all know our weather can quickly change significantly. Online, the best weather forecast site is the Bureau of Meteorology's Meteye. <a href="http://www.bom.gov.au/australia/meteye/index.shtml">http://www.bom.gov.au/australia/meteye/index.shtml</a> as it gives you 3 hourly outlooks on the exact area you plan to go boating in and, if planning a longer trip, there are detailed 7 day outlooks.

It's also essential you have all the required safety gear. By January 2021 all Tasmanian boaters will be required to have the new AS4758 standard life jackets. This date will see the end of a 10 year transition from the old PFD 1,2 and 3 type life jackets. MAST is offering \$20.00 vouchers — just keep an eye on the MAST Facebook and website to see where their staff may be over the coming summer. Take your old jackets along for MAST to mark them then you have until December 2020 to purchase your new AS4758 jackets with a \$20 upfront discount. Safe Boating.



The **SAPRA AGM** is coming up in November (see notice on p.1) so please put the date in your diary and come along. We hope to have a guest speaker – more news on that later.





formation, support and strategies to help as well as linking you to relevant services that can assist.

It doesn't matter what the issue is when someone is experiencing high levels of stress and feeling alone. What matters is that someone demonstrates a caring, confidential and non-intrusive approach to helping, and being available when the help is most needed.

RAW provides accessible and responsive support services to all rural communities. Assisting the community in the response to crisis, and help in recovering or coping after adversity. They establish structures and networks to assist individuals, families and communities to deal with suicide.

Further support services is provided to individuals and their families at risk of mental health problems and suicide.
