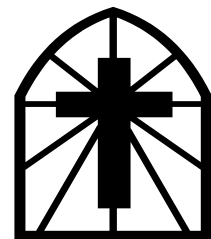
DON'T LET YOUR LACK OF HOUSE NUMBER MEAN YOUR NUMBER'S UP

This might seem like a harsh statement but in the case of an emergency, those coming to help need to be able to find you quickly. Across the peninsula we have a mix of street houses/shacks, dirt roads, bush blocks, and beach tracks and its not always easy to find the right house. Medical teams need to be working on you, not out on the street trying to work out where your house is. Minutes are critical, especially in the case of heart attacks, to say nothing of how a fire could take hold just like that. Please, make sure your house number is very clear both night and day. **Exhibit A (to the right) fails!**

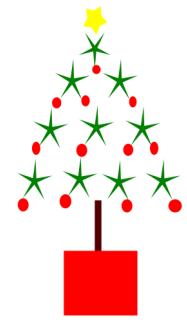

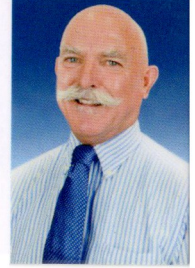

Passion, persistence, and perspiration characterise, Sandford's 15-year-old Charles Harrex's dedication to the flourishing sport of futsal. His selection to the Australian 15 Boys' Futsal Team, travelling to Brazil last month, represents his greatest achievement to date.

The indoor five-a-side football game places considerable demands on the player. Fitness, technique, spatial and tactical awareness are all vital skills to develop, with fast reflexes, quick thinking and pinpoint passing making it popular with players and spectators alike.

Charles started playing at the age of 10, representing both his primary school and high school, as well as club teams and a social men's team, competing in many Southern Tasmanian Futsal rosters. In his first year he was picked to play in Brisbane with a Tasmanian team, and, for the fifth year running, is bound for Sydney in January as a member of the Tasmanian 15 Boys' team.

Charles's knowledge and skills have been nurtured through the Futsal Institute of Tasmania's pathway development programs of Gol Brasil School, futsal free-style, and state training programs, conducted by national and international skills and strategy coaches. This year, he has begun contributing back to the sport by undertaking a refereeing training course.

In mid-November, Charles leaves for Brazil for a 19-day tour, involving training sessions with internationally-recognised futsal coaches, and playing matches against selected Brazilian teams in Belo Horizonte, north-west of Rio de Janeiro. 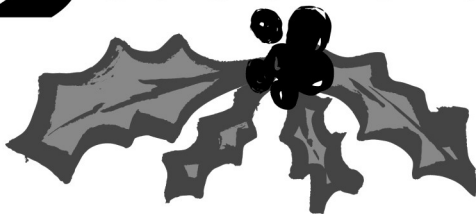
**SCHOLARSHIP OFFERED FOR FIRST

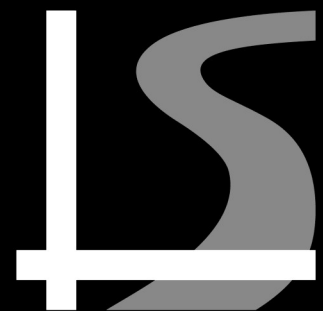

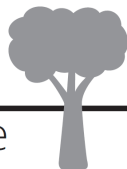

CALVERTON HALL: CENTRE STAGE

This year I was privileged to see a pantomime performed by the Grade 5/6 students of South Arm Primary School. It was fantastic. Congratulations to the children, Principal and staff, and to the two young men who produced it. While I was there I thought how lucky we are to have the Calverton Hall venue. Do you know its history?

1. The hall is over 100 years old and started as the cricket pavilion. It was on private land and was erected by the local community of the time.
2. Early in the 1980's the owner of the land decided to give the land the building and tennis court to the Council (it was getting very expensive to maintain.) An agreement was signed so that it remained recreation space for the community.
3. The Council renovated the building and then the area—hall, oval and tennis court—was leased to a committee to look after. This continues to this day.
4. In 2000 it became obvious that new curtains for the stages were needed and an idea was floated to have a Bare to Be Different calendar to raise the money.
5. The calendar sold extremely well and as well as new curtains a dressing room was built behind the stage and the kitchen was remodelled.
6. The stage curtains needed to be motorized and with the help of Piggery Productions this was done.
7. In 2007, the tennis court surface had become so badly cracked the court had to be closed. A grant from the Council supplemented the Hall funds allowing for a new supergrass surface to be installed.
8. The barbecue facilities, financed by the Hall Committee, SAPRA and the Council were added in 2011.
9. The cricket pitch needs attention. Until the 1970's there was a strong cricket team in the district and all the equipment is still here. But???

Following hot on the tails of the school pantomime — a community bush dance! It was a fantastic event and it was great to see so many people get involved.

The South Arm school band "Midnight Fire" drew a big crowd. The lucky dip, photo booth, face painting, counting jelly beans and snail racing provided entertainment and the food options were well received. The hall could not fit in another person for the bush dance and the band "Buttongrass Serenade" had everyone heel and toeing, spinning and dosie doing.

BUSHFIRE-READY!
NOW IS THE TIME TO PREPARE YOUR HOME FOR THE BUSHFIRE SEASON

The weather is getting warmer, we have had good spring rains with significant vegetation growth. The fire potential is high once the vegetation dries out but do not wait until the last minute before taking action.

You must reduce the potential for a bushfire to impact your property now. Create a defensible space around your home by removing flammable materials to reduce the possibility of sparks and embers igniting your home.

Cut, slash and remove long grass and leaf litter around your property. Clear leaves and debris from your gutters and downpipes. Remove wood heaps and other fuel from contact with your house.

Prepare your fire safety plan now so that all members of your household know what to do and where to go when a bushfire approaches. Prepare an emergency kit with medications, a radio and valuable items you can take if you must leave.

Heed the emergency warnings and be prepared to act with short notice. It is too late to start preparation once the fire is underway. Much of the preparation for bushfires can and should be undertaken by property owners well before any fire starts.

SENSE IN THE SUN

Approximately two-thirds of Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer by the age of 70. In Australia in 2016, it is estimated that 13,283 new cases of melanoma skin cancer will be diagnosed. As summer approaches, these statistics should serve as a wake-up call to all Australians about the importance of sun protection.



The well-known ‘Slip, Slop, Slap’ campaign, initiated some 35 years ago, has been recognised as one of Australia’s most successful health campaigns. The campaign has more recently been modified to ‘Slip, Slop, Slap, Seek and Slide’ (referring to seeking shade and sliding on wrap-around sunglasses to prevent sun damage).

A combination of these sun protection measures along with getting to know your skin and regularly checking so you can pick up on any changes are the keys to reducing skin cancer risk.

It’s important to get to know your own skin and identify sun damage. A first step is to check with your doctor or pharmacist if you have doubts about any changes either in skin appearance or in the colour of moles and freckles. The Cancer Council website also has useful information on checking for signs of skin cancer.
