CLIFTON BEACH SLSC NEWS

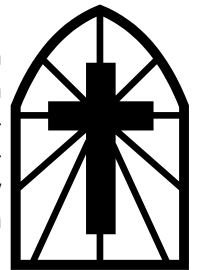

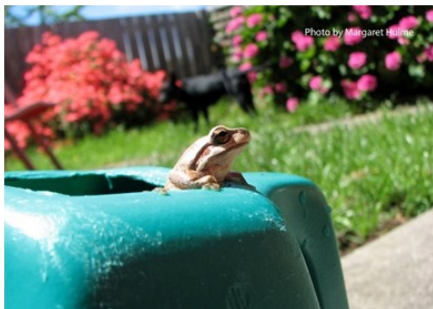

STORIES FROM THE (Seashore) GARDEN (Things that make our Peninsula special)

Frogs. People are finding them everywhere; cupped in the strappy leaves of bromeliads; sitting in the saucer under a pot plant; in the watering can; swimming in the goose pond. Mostly we see the little (up to 45mm) Brown



Tree Frog, who calls every night with a 'ree-ree-ree-ree' a bit like a cricket. You will have heard the distinctive Pobblebonk or Banjo Frog (up to 65mm) who has a melodious banjo-like "bong ... bong." The notes are well separated, but if there are several calling it's all joined together "bong-bong-bong-bong" and you can hear the different intonations from the different frogs. Another one that I hear is the Spotted Marsh Frog. A smallish frog at 45mm – it has spots with a yellow stripe down the middle of its back. The Spotted Marsh Frog has a clear "ick ... ick" like two stones tapped together, the notes are well separated.

Having frogs singing always cheers me as it indicates our environment is not too polluted. Also, they are very useful little friends keeping down mozzie larvae. A friend had frogs that would sit at the kitchen window at night and catch the mossies that flew to the light. Happy Christmas from the frogs!

HISTORY & HERITAGE

In the August newsletter I wrote about the Oakleigh Subdivision and how it all developed by Mr Murrium Sweet. Development of the first part commenced on 7 June 1961 from lot 9 next to Fort Direction Rd to lot 48, and ranged in price 300 pounds to 200 pounds (\$600-\$400). Finance was available at 25 pound deposit for three years at 7% interest reducible each six months. I know many people took advantage of this offer and arranged with Mr Sweet to suit their personal needs. The best of these sites soon sold and the next stage from lot 49 to lot 178 all on Blessington St was opened. By then money had changed to decimal currency and the price of these allotments varied according to position and beach frontage. They ranged from \$900 to \$950 with several selling for \$1,450. On the plan I have (dated 1969) it shows most of the allotments on the beach front (Spring Beach) and several on the top side of Blessington St as sold. In the following years most of the lots were sold with the completion of the remaining lots to the end of Blessington St next to Fort Direction Commonwealth land. The remaining land between Blessington St and Fort direction Rd consisting of 11 five acre allotments went on the market. Many of these were snapped up by the local people selling between \$5600 and \$4200, with one well known person purchasing three 5 acre allotments. Pauline and I – having lived in Blessington Street since 1963 – have watched how all this has developed. Having grown up on the land that once belonged to my Great Grandfather the late George Alomes and my grandfather Edward Alomes and his brother Leslie Alomes who share farmed the land until it was divided between them in 1948 with the road to Fort Direction being the division between the properties. About this time Les Alomes sold several lots of land opposite the local store to above the South Arm jetty. The land above this had been laid out in Coxes Orange, Cherries and Pear trees, the remaining land had been used to grow wheat and hay. By 1954 three lots of land was sold and the construction of the first RSL Clubhouse began. Today the old RSL Clubhouse is occupied by the coffee shop, hair dresser and the pharmacy.

I wish to thank all those people who have supplied information and photos of Collis Watson. I have now passed on the photos and the information to his remaining family who have been very happy to learn what happened to Collis from 1950 to now. It has filled in those many blank years when they neither heard from him or knew he was living in Tasmania. In the not too distant future the family hope to visit South Arm.

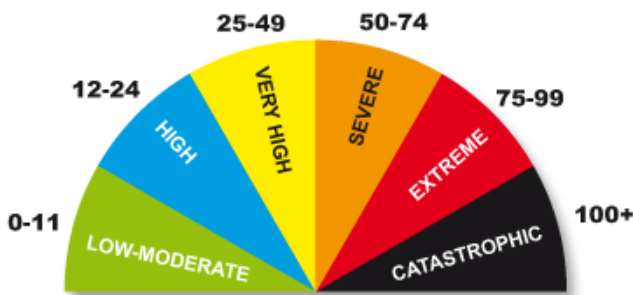

SOUTH ARM FIRE BRIGADE

We are now approaching the fire season and the Brigade again urges all residents and shack owners to be familiar with the fire danger levels.



The TFS held its pre fire season briefing for Brigades last week and advised that the recent wet conditions could mean we will have a later start to the bushfire season this year, but the warm air over the centre of Australia will move over Tasmania early in 2014 leading to similar bush-fire conditions to last season.

During the bushfire season, fire danger ratings forecast for Tasmania will be available on the Bureau of Meteorology website, the Tasmania Fire Service website and on the weather page of Tasmania's daily newspapers. You should listen for warnings on ABC Radio or check the TFS website at www.fire.tas.gov.au to find out where fires are burning. Power supplies and phones are likely to fail in a bushfire. If power fails, listen to fire updates on your car radio.

During Fire Danger Levels of Catastrophic, Extreme, Severe, and Very High you should frequently check outside

conditions outside your home. If smoke is blowing towards you, a fire is approaching and you should leave immediately by a safe route, away from the fire. Please don't wait for an official warning. If ash or burning embers are landing in your yard, the fire is very close and it may be too late to leave. If this is the case, take shelter in your home. Fill your bath and all available containers with water, and actively defend your home by using the water to put out any parts of your home that catch fire. Alternatively and if time permits, go immediately to a nearby safe place.

The Tasmanian Fire Service has a number of booklets/ brochures available via their website <http://www.fire.tas.gov.au/Show?pagelid=colPublications>

These include:- **Bushfire Prepare to Survive With Bushfire Survival Plan, Using Fire Outdoors and Fire Resisting Garden Plants.** Also available through the TFS is the "**Bushfire Prepare to Survive DVD**"

It is expected that the Fire Permit season will be declared before Xmas. Permit Officers for the South Arm and Oposum Bay area are: Richard Calvert | 6239 412, Barry Heather | 6239 9564, Brett Arnold | 6239 9259 and Glenn Palmer | 6239 9346.

On a lighter note the brigade and fire truck will be at a number of local community events over the Christmas period, but of course operational needs will always take precedence. Finally, the South Arm Fire Brigade wishes all residents, shack owners and visitors a happy, safe and fire free Xmas and New Year, and thank you all for your support during the last 12 months.

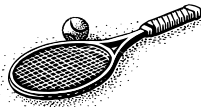
