TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The scholarship is for an amount of \$3,000 and is granted to one individual per calendar year.
2. It is to help with the first-year costs of further education (e.g. University, TasTAFE, skills institute etc.) or an apprenticeship/traineeship.
3. Applicants must be under the age of 21 as at 31 December 2026.
4. Eligible applicants are:
 - a) Club Members,
 - b) Children/grandchildren of a Member, or
 - c) Anyone under 21 who lives, or whose parents live, on the South Arm Peninsula defined as south of, and including, Forest Hill Rd.
5. Funds to be spent on items relevant to the course/apprenticeship within the first year of study.
6. To be eligible, applicants must submit this completed form and associated submission by 31 March 2026.
7. The South Arm RSL & Community Club Committee will consider all applications and make a final decision.
8. All applicants will be notified in writing of the result by early May 2026. The decision of the Club will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. The recipient undertakes to:
 - a) Provide details and proof of purchase for items bought with these funds.
 - b) Provide regular written updates to the Committee on their progress (minimum at the end of each semester or every four months, whichever applicable) for the following twelve months. (These need only be short but include results.)
 - c) Advise the Committee if studies/apprenticeship are suspended or ceased for any reason.
 - d) Return the funds, or part thereof, should the Committee deem the applicant has not complied with the terms and conditions and/or with the spirit of the scholarship.
